THE SIXTH LORD MAYOR'S ART AWARD

JANUARY, 1970

The Corporation of the City of London will arrange the Sixth Lord Mayor's Art Award in the Guildhall Art Gallery during January 1970.

The Corporation's policy of encouraging painters to record the tradition, the established beauty and the new development of London will be continued in this way and the sum of £500 is to be made available for awards. The Corporation will also consider the purchase of suitable works for their permanent collection.

On this occasion it is intended to extend the scope of the Exhibition to include pictures of the full Metropolitan area of London; that is all parts of Central London with numbered postal districts.

There will be no submission fees or hanging fees on accepted works and no commission will be charged on works sold.

All paintings must depict some aspect of life or landscape in London and the main emphasis should be on buildings and projects, people at work, street or river scenes, and ceremonial occasions.

Artists may submit four works and no work must exceed 40 inches by 30 inches in size unframed. Works may be in oils, watercolours, pastel, tempera, black and white, or artists prints. (Sculpture is not admissible.)

Works must be delivered unpacked at the Guildhall Art Gallery, London EC2, on Monday 22nd December 1969 (9 am to 4 pm).
