Quite frequently, the President or another officer of the Royal Society of British Artists receives a letter from family descendants or picture owners enquiring about some Victorian painter of whom they know nothing except that he 'exhibited at the RBA'. Sometimes we can help, sometimes we can only refer these researchers to the Victoria and Albert Museum which now holds our archives. But each time we are reminded that for over one hundred and fifty years, the RBA as one of the oldest exhibiting societies, has afforded a window each year to the public world for artists, some famous, some remembered and some whose very artistic identity persists in their having exhibited with us.

But all of them have shown because their work has been seen as worthy of exhibition on the walls of this society by their fellow artists.

This is the way in which our exhibitions are still formed. The works are chosen, to the best of our judgement, on the merit they exhibit in their own terms, and not because they display some stylistic or commercial fashion. So we hope that this show gives some conspectus of what is actually going on in our art world, rather than a particular view of what art ought to look like.

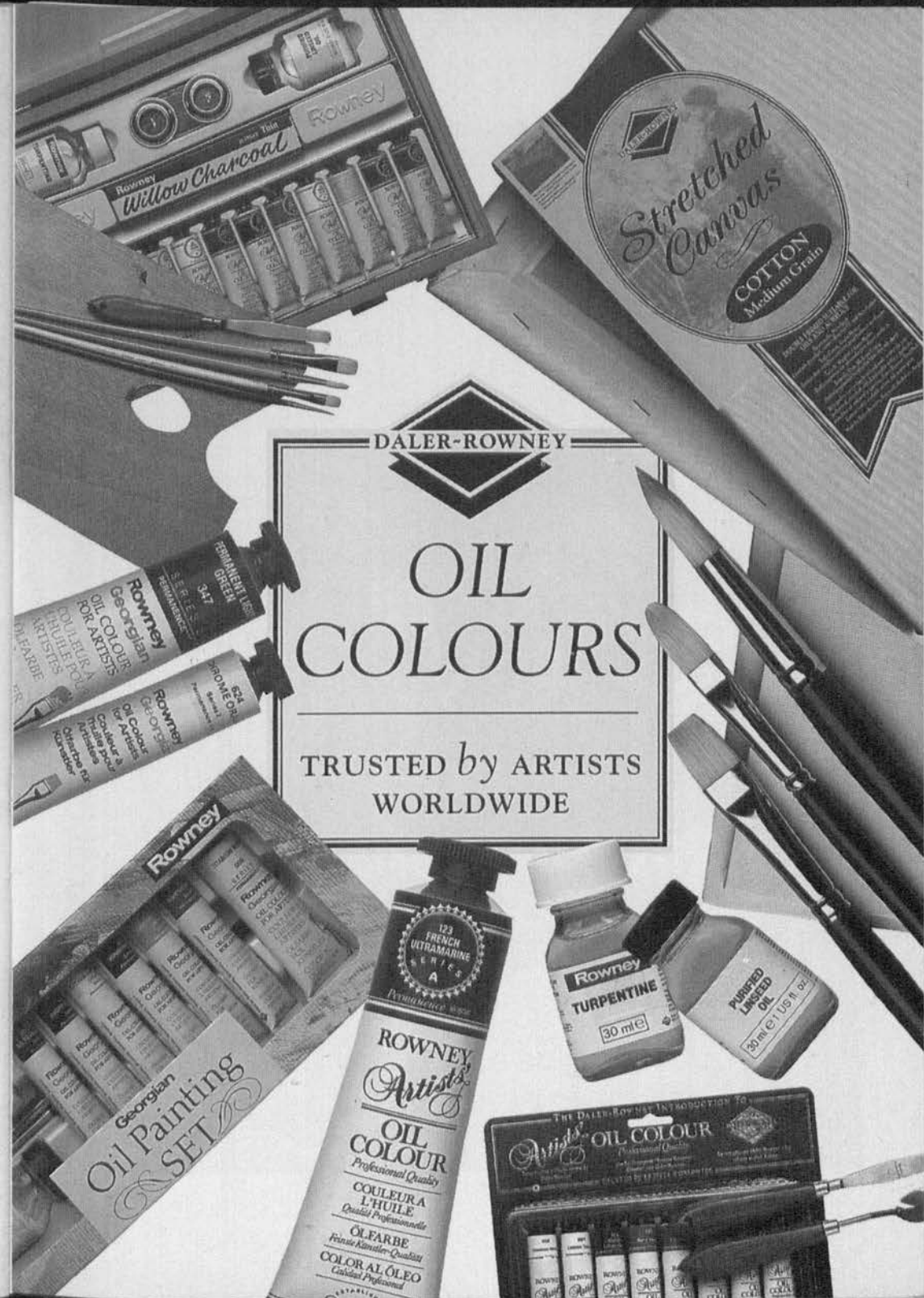

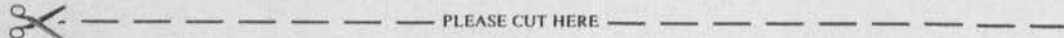
