You can see good work round the galleries of London by artists you have heard of, and of whom you know, up to a point, what to expect.

You must, as often as not, come to the Societies to find equally good works by artists you have perhaps not heard of, and which may provide you with quite the unexpected.

This is what the Royal Society of British Artists hopes to present to you each year. It has its membership, on which the substance of the exhibition must depend: beyond this, the selectors choose work solely on quality, without regard to and often without the knowledge of the signatures. We are happy if they sell, but nothing is picked for its potential sales value. If this is what makes the activities of Art Societies (and we must think of our own particularly at this time) unfashionable in our economic climate, it is what justifies their abiding existence.

After the close of the exhibition, and only after payment of the purchase price, the work will be handed to the purchaser, or his agent authorised in writing, on application at 17 Carlton House Terrace, London SW1Y 5BD.


