President's Foreword

Delacroix once said 'I can paint the flesh of Venus with mud, provided you let me surround it as I will' and Degas is quoted as saying 'The art of painting is to make burnt sienna look like vermillion'. Quotations such as these by painters – and sculptors will have their own also – demonstrate that for more than a millennium artists have occupied their minds with creative challenges that are just as valid now as they were in Giotto's day.

The art of drawing has not changed for even longer than a millennium. Personally, I find it both exciting and reassuring that when we sit down to draw with a piece of charcoal and paper there is nothing that separates us from a Renaissance artist of 500 years ago. It is just as difficult for us as it was for them and, of course, just as rewarding.

This is a magical link to many hundreds of artists before us, all trying to make sense of the world through their art. This surely will live for ever as long as people take an interest in what is going on around them.

Having spent many hours, along with my Council, preparing and selecting work for this 296th exhibition, I feel confident that this will be a show that embraces everything I have just outlined and contains much of the best work available to see in this country, or any other for that matter.

As in previous years, we are proud to be showing the best of young artists' work from NADFAS and The Dover Federation for the Arts. This has proven to be a thoroughly worthwhile, positive and encouraging scheme for young people to be part of, and to gain serious recognition for their efforts. I would like to add that each year it also becomes more difficult to select from what is an increasingly high standard of work submitted.

On a particularly positive note I am delighted by the response we have had from sculptors this year and, as a consequence, will be showing more high-quality works than for many years. I would also like to give a special welcome to James Butler RA, who will be exhibiting with us this year. I would also like to thank all the invited artists who have provided us with work for inclusion in the show.

As a testimonial to a Past President of the Society, we are delighted to be able to show a selection of work by Sir Alfred East. To this end I am extremely grateful to Paul Lewis, his great stepson, for all his efforts in getting the pictures together.

Thanks must also go to the family of Sir Philip de László, also a past president, for their continuing interest and support in RBA matters. This will be the first occasion that the Society will be using the newly refurbished gallery, now called the Threadneedle Space. This is an exciting new space that will enable the Society to show as many distinguished works as possible.

As in previous years, several of the members will be giving a full range of demonstrations, open to everyone, during the exhibition.

It only remains for me to say welcome to you all and please enjoy what I am confident will be a very special exhibition.



The Rome Scholarship



Naomi Grant Self Portrait

"In the weeks leading up to my departure for Rome, I had a clear sense of the sort of paintings I wanted to make. I had been schooled in the rhetoric of pure observation and had been looking at the early works of Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot. I imagined myself setting up an easel on the Palatine hill or outside the walls of the Farnese gardens and working, as Corot had, nearly two hundred years ago.

My actual experience at the British School complicated my thinking in ways I could not have anticipated. I visited the Borghese gardens every day and sat and drew and painted but nothing worked. Corot had been able capture the distinctive warmth and character of the Italian light but I seemed unable to achieve its peculiar intensity. Scale, too, proved challenging. The pine trees which populate the ruins of the city functioned (or should have functioned) as a kind of staffage but I could not work out how to use them as cleverly as Corot and his contemporaries had done and I was aware that my

pictures lacked the structural intelligence of the works I so admired.

The opportunity to see the Villa Livia frescoes in the Palazzo Massimo proved something of a turning point. I was excited to see so many different forms of perception at work in a single image; acts of acute empirical observation were allied to imagined, constructed spaces. A trip to the Archaeological Museum in Naples brought me into contact with the sheer breadth and range of Roman art for the first time. I was attracted by the intimacy of the still lifes—works which prompted me to think more carefully about the role of construction, invention and memory in the images of the painters I most respected.

Returning to London has allowed me to continue my engagement with both Roman art and nineteenth-century landscape painting. Corot's works seem all the more elusive and beautiful for my visit; they are at once intuitive and considered, observed and invented. I am truly grateful to the RBA for such an enriching opportunity."
